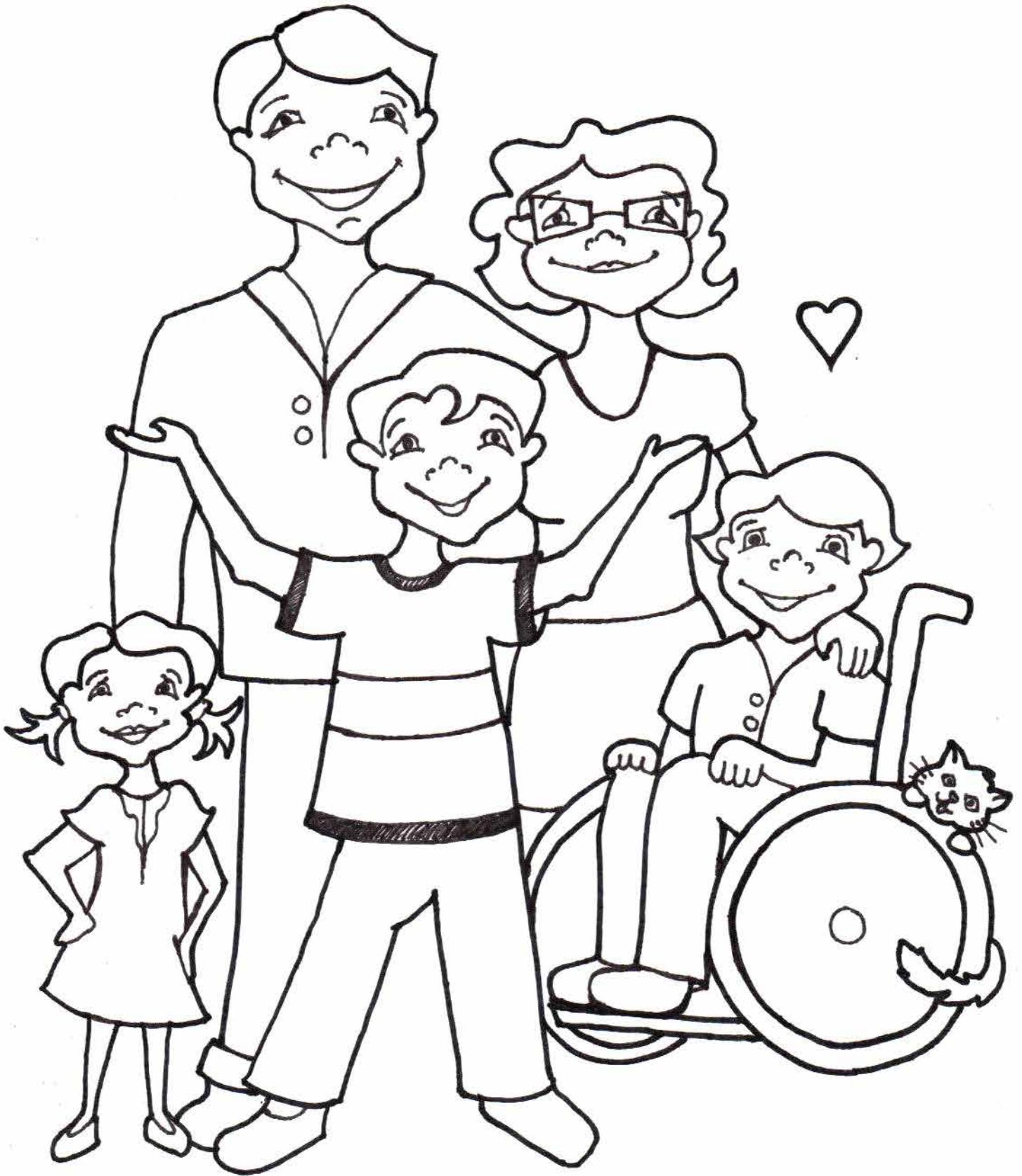

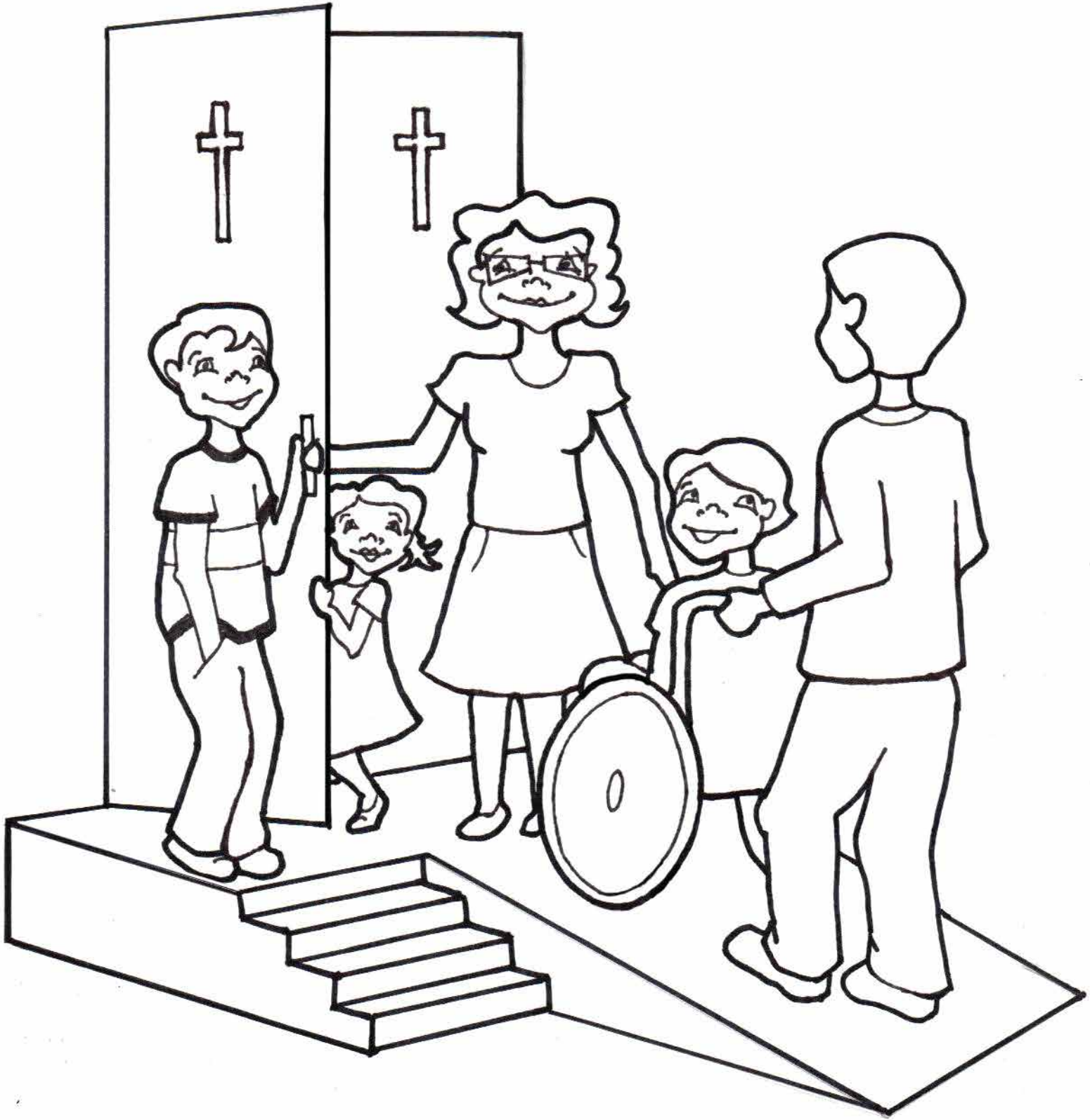

During the week, I go to school. Here are some of the kids in my class. We just heard a great joke. Do you know any jokes?



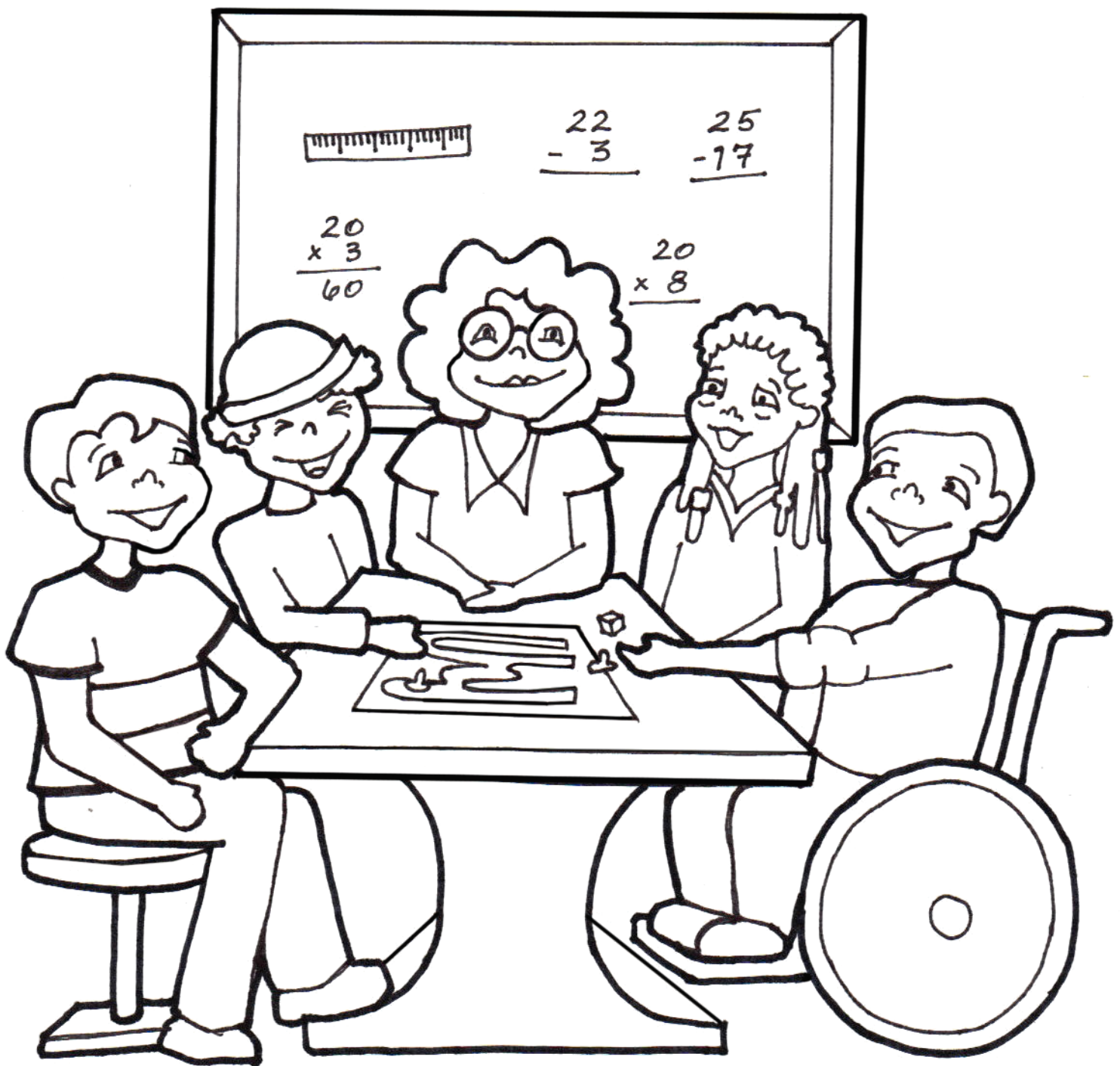
My favorite thing about school is story time. My reading partner is Peter. Sometimes I read to Peter and sometimes Peter reads to me. Can you tell what Peter is reading?



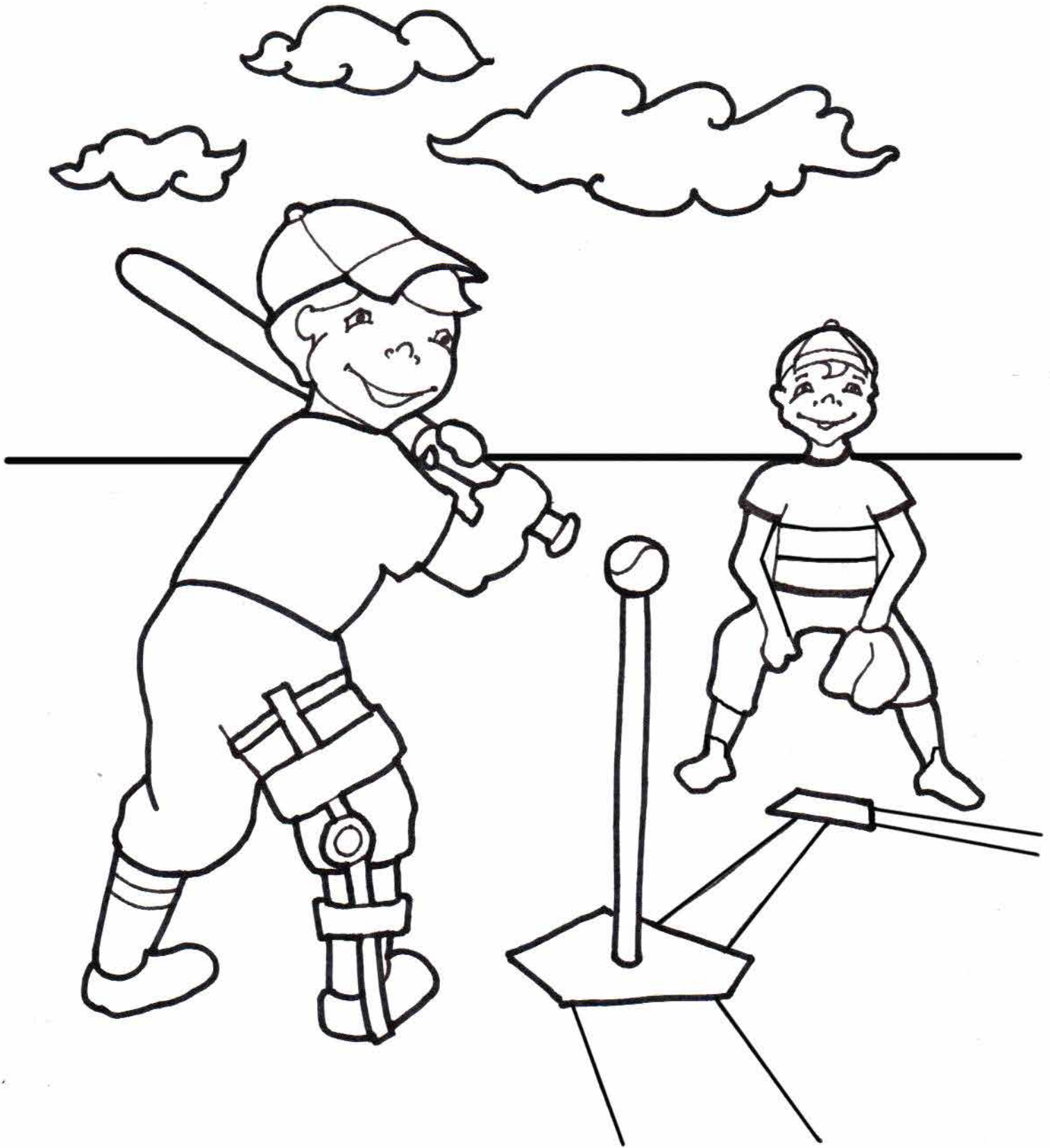


I love recess. I could spend all day on the playground!
